10	25/10/2017	ThinkTank	Undeb Spring Cleans and Litter pick festival in February (Gaz) - mass litter picks involving students, community and university - Gaz says they have volunteers but need drivers. Waste outside university boundaries and at private student accommodation a problem, can this be tackled?
